

Step 8: Exploring Financial Support Options

Homeschooling can bring additional financial responsibilities, particularly when supporting a child with developmental delays. Fortunately, several financial support options are available to help cover the costs of educational resources, therapies, and day-to-day expenses related to Kove's care. Arlie can apply for funding through government programs such as Centrelink and the National Disability Insurance Scheme (NDIS).

Available Financial Support Options

1. Centrelink Carer Allowance

The Carer Allowance is a fortnightly payment to assist people caring for a child with additional needs. It is not means-tested and can help cover homeschooling-related expenses such as learning materials and therapy costs.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Kove must have a diagnosed condition that affects his daily functioning.
- Arlie must provide daily care and supervision.

How to Apply:

1. Visit the Centrelink website:

2. Log in to MyGov and select Centrelink.
3. Submit an online application and upload required medical evidence.
4. Request Kove's healthcare provider to complete the **Medical Report (SA431)** form.
5. Await assessment and payment approval.

Documents Needed:

- Medical reports from paediatricians, therapists, and other specialists.
 - Evidence of daily care requirements (e.g., therapy schedules, support letters).
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2. Centrelink Carer Payment

The Carer Payment is an income-support payment for those providing full-time care to a child with a severe condition. Unlike the Carer Allowance, this payment is means-tested.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Full-time caregiving responsibilities that prevent Arlie from engaging in full-time work.
- Household income and assets within allowable limits.

How to Apply:

1. Visit the Centrelink website:

 2. Submit an application online through MyGov.
 3. Provide medical documentation and financial information.
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3. National Disability Insurance Scheme (NDIS)

The NDIS provides funding for children with disabilities and developmental delays, covering therapies, assistive technology, and support services that can be integrated into Kove's homeschooling plan.

Key Benefits for Homeschooling:

- Funding for occupational, speech, and physical therapies.
- Learning aids and sensory equipment to support education.
- Support worker funding to assist with caregiving responsibilities.

How to Apply:

1. Visit the NDIS website:

2. Call 1800 800 110 to request an access form.
3. Submit supporting documents, including medical evidence and therapist reports.
4. Attend a planning meeting to discuss Kove's support needs.

Documents Needed:

- Diagnosis reports from paediatricians and therapists.
- A support letter from a GP or specialist outlining Kove's needs.
- Evidence of how funding will be used in his homeschooling journey.

4. State-Based Financial Support Programs

Western Australia offers additional support through local disability and family services. Arlie may be eligible for grants or concessions specific to WA families homeschooling children with special needs.
